## **Departmental Activities During 2022-23**

### Excursion and Field Study at Neli, Morigaon



An excursion cum field study was organized by the department for its students of various categories to Neli area of Morigaon District, Assam. The trip was organized on 27-05-2023. The main purpose of the field trip was to visit

Gopal Krishna Tea Estate located in the area. Students visited the Estate to know the role of the Estate in employment generation in the locality. How the Tea Estate changed the economic conditions of the local communities was also studied through asking relevant questions to the workers of the factory. Moreover, the trend of tea production and its export pattern and income generation were also taken into consideration during the field visit.

### **Introduction of Certificate Courses**

The department is very pleased to introduce two certificate courses on **Map making & Analysis** and **Geographical Information System** during 2022-23. The certificate course on Map Making & Analysis was started from March, 2023 and ended in June, 2023. Students have learnt many new techniques on map making process and analysis part. Another certificate course is



currently going on and is expected to be completed by the end of October, 2023. The course on GIS techniques will give students basic information of GIS software with map processing techniques. The course covers topics like, Georeferencing, Visual Image Interpretation, Raster and Vector Data, Land Use and Land Cover Map etc.

### **State Level Seminar**



Department of Geography, Moirabari College has organized one State Level Seminar on 24-06-2023. The seminar was organized in presence of the Principal of the college and other invited personalities from different institutions. **Dr. Sourav Saha**, Assistant Professor of Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankardeva Viswavidyalaya was

invited as **Resource Person** to the seminar, who delivered a lecture cum presentation on "Traditional Knowledge-Based Natural Resource Management System in N.E. India: Changes and Sustainability." The resource person has highlighted how natural resources can be managed traditionally in a sustainable manner by giving burning examples from different parts of the North east India. He has given examples from the tribal states of the region with relevant photographs which were very comprehensive. At the end of his session, many participants raised questions to him on various resource-based issues, and they were replied accordingly. Many participants from different institutions like Soraibahi College, Bhuragaon College etc. were physically presented in the seminar and presented their papers. Some participants were also joined the seminar through online mode. The seminar was successfully ended with a concluding remark from Head of the Department.
