Programme Outcome, Programme Specific Outcome and Course Outcome

ASSAMESE	Programme Outcome	The under graduate course in Assamese (Major) deals with literature, language and culture. It includes Assamese literature from the 9th to the 21st century. It also consists Western and Eastern Literature and Cultural History. Various aspects like tourism, archaeology, agriculture and fashion are incorporated in the cultural History paper. This particular paper helps the students to acquire knowledge on indigenous dress and ornaments. It also includes information on various religious and historical places of interest and archaeology. It also covers a lot of information on various aspects of agriculture of Assam.
	Programme Specific Outcome	After completion of this course students would gather knowledge about Assamese culture and tradition. This course also provides skills in creative writing through its language paper. It also brings competence in the language which empowers them with communicative skills.
	Course Outcome	After passing out with Major in Assamese students can either opt for academics or professional courses. They can pursue Post Graduation in literature, Linguistics, Culture Studies, Mass Communication, Tourism etc. The passed out students, if interested can also go for Fashion Designing and Beautician courses. They can engage themselves as teachers and also as entrepreneurs in agriculture.
ARABIC	Programme Outcome	Undergraduate course in Arabic deals with language, literature and culture. It includes Arabic modern prose and poetry. It also incorporates political history of Islam. The syllabus also requires the students to learn Arabic grammar and translation.
	Programme Specific Outcome	After successful completion of the course students will gain information on the history of Islam. They will gain knowledge on Arabic language and literature, modern prose and poetry.
	Course Outcome	On completion of the course the students can opt for higher education and chose a career in education. They can also opt for administrative jobs.
ECONOMICS	Programme Outcome	The undergraduate programme provides a well structured, contemporary curricular for the students which would prepare them for employment opportunities as well as for higher education. It also provides the students with the knowledge of applied economics. They would learn how the classroom teaching in economics is applied in practice.
	Programme Specific Outcome	The teaching of different courses in economics would help the students to acquire in-depth knowledge and understanding of the functioning and performance of the Indian and other global economies. The course tries to provide knowledge on analyzing micro and macro-economic policies. It would also equip the students with the knowledge of fiscal and monetary policies in India. Students would be able to understand economic Variables like inflation, unemployment, poverty, gross domestic product, etc. after completion of this course. This course would also help the students to understand the behaviour of financial and money markets which would further help them in their professional and day to day life. During the course, students would be equipped quantitative analytical skills with the help of which they will be able to collect, tabulate, present and analyse data to support economic decision making. They will also acquired analytical and reasoning skill.

	Course Outcome	<p>After successful completion of this course, the students can opt for various academic as well as professional courses. It also prepares students for a career as researchers in the field of economics. This course equip the students with a knowledge base to compete for various examinations in the Banking and Administrative sectors. It also empowers them to take up entrepreneurship and business.</p> <p>The students would also learn about different aspects of planning .They will also learn about India in the global economy. This course will also help the students to understand the economic problems of North-East India.</p>
ENGLISH	Programme Outcome	The undergraduate course in English mostly deals with English literature and its history. The course also includes women's writing, nature writing, literacy theory and criticism and linguistic. It makes the students familiar with different literary genres-fiction, non-fiction, poetry, plays, biography, autobiography, journal, film. Plays, etc.
	Programme Specific Outcome	This course acquaints students with the perspective of English literary tradition. Students are required to read and relate the circumstances that influenced, shaped and contributed to the process of literary production from the medieval to the renaissance. Students are also opened to the wide range of poetry and fiction of the modern and postmodern eras that are representative of important trends, critical shifts and formal experimentation. The course includes literary cultures of British, American and the Latin American. Students are introduced to the 20 th century English and European historical and cultural situation that prepared the ground for avant-garde theatre with its stylistic/technical innovations and thematic experimentation. The paper on writing by women introduces students to a body of literature that has emerged over the years. It invites students to examine how women's texts pay attention to the historical and political conditions of their times, to the status and condition of women and to the ways in which they embody a politics of resistance.
	Course Outcome	The course will enable students to acquire sound comprehension of social, cultural, biographical, historical background of British and other European literature, American literature, Indian Writing in English. As the course is basically multi-disciplinary the students have a lot of career-options – teaching, News Media, Communication Media, Tourism Industry, as Air Hostess etc. They can opt for further studies in English, Linguistics, Culture Studies, Folklore, MBA, Mass Communication, Tourism, Law etc.
EDUCATION	Programme Outcome	The Under Graduate programme in Education aims to develop a holistic and multi-dimensional understanding of the aims, objectives, functions and role of Education. The course includes the Indian and Western schools of philosophy and their impact on Education. It enables the students to learn the philosophy of life of different educational thinkers and their works. The course comprises of an understanding of different perspectives of Psychology and various theories of intelligence, different types of personality and adjustment mechanism, nature of learning role of motivation in learning, concept of memory, forgetting attention and interest. History of Education comprises of pre and post Indian Education system and recommendations of different Education Commissions are also included in the course.
	Programme Specific	The Under Graduate course in Education helps the students in developing competencies on different fields of real life situations

HISTORY	Outcome	and challenges. Thereby opening various avenues for self discovery, academic understanding and employment. After successful completion of this course the students can apply their knowledge in social context which they have acquired from lectures, group discussions, experiments, project works, presentation, field tours and home assignments etc. On successful completion of the course the students become efficient for teaching activities and guiding others to become good citizens in the society by usage of value education. It also helps the students in development of their personality. The course also enables the students to learn about psychology with its allied aspects as memory, attention and interest, instinct and emotion, learning, personality, intelligence, creativity, adjustments and mental health. The course also enlightens the learners with the knowledge of development of education from ancient to present period along with the development of education in Assam. It acquaints the students with the philosophical thoughts of different Indian and Western Educational thinkers along with their contribution to present day education thoughts. This course also helps the students to understand the basic concept of Statistics including different statistical procedures used in educational field. The main purpose of the Project work is to acquire practical knowledge on the investigation of any problem studied through field work.
	Course Outcome	The course prepares students for higher studies in Education and Psychology. It equips students for various avenues like research, teaching, competitive examinations, jobs in DIET, etc.
GEOGRAPHY	Programme Outcome	The three year Under Graduate course in Geography equips the students with knowledge in different areas of Geography-geomorphology, oceanography, climatology, world regional geography, soil and biology, economic geography, human geography, development planning, cartography, statistics.
	Programme Specific Outcome	The students of Geography at Undergraduate level would acquire knowledge regarding brief regional account of the continents: physiography, climate, natural vegetation, population growth, density and distribution and major population density zones. The course includes syllabus regarding Geomorphology in the field of Physical Geography. They would be provided basic knowledge about the origin and development of landforms under different environmental conditions. It helps the students to know Regional geography of Asia in terms of location, physiography, climate population growth and distribution, agriculture and industries. Students would also learn about the human adaptation and adjustment with their environment and mode of living and emerging problems in different environments. They would learn and understand the physical characteristics, distribution, origin and diffusion of major racial groups in the world. They would familiarize themselves with different approaches in the field of Human Geography. Students are motivated to gather knowledge on remote sensing, geographical information and global positioning system. They would learn the application of Remote Sensing, GIS and GPS in geographical studies. It also helps them to develop their skills on computer assisted cartography. They can prepare and analyze maps and diagrams using various softwares. The paper would provide the students knowledge on formulation of research problem. It would motivate students to search knowledge from every walk of life.
	Course Outcome	The students gain knowledge in different areas of geography. The field trips and outdoor classes organized by the department give the

		students the opportunity to apply their classroom knowledge in real life. Students are exposed to the topics like eco-tourism, manner of tourist flow, species identification, socio-economic study of people of different communities. The students are given training in the use of Geographical Information System (GIS) etc.
HISTORY	Programme Outcome	The undergraduate course in history comprises of ancient, medieval and modern Indian History. The course also includes history of Great Britain, European history and International relations. It also includes the history of Eastern countries like China and Japan. The syllabus tries to give the students an insight into the regional history by including the history of Assam of different periods.
	Programme Specific Outcome	The students of history at undergraduate level would learn about the history of history writing from the time of Greek tradition. Students will also gather information regarding different branches of history and would learn about the importance of evidence and facts in history while questioning the objectivity in history. The course deals with past events as a continuous, systematic, narrative of the past events as relating to a particular people, country, period, persons etc. written as a chronological account and relating to the present. Students would have an understanding-its economy and administration. They would also learn about the Mughal rulers, administration, art and architecture and India's vibrant economic growth under the Mughals. Very importantly, the students would learn about the consolidation of British power in Assam, resistance against the British and the national movement in Assam. The final year students of this course would learn about collection of data and facts and methods of presentation in history. They would also learn about citing sources and references an about preparing bibliography and finally would learn about presenting the findings and drafting a dissertation which would be very helpful for them in their higher studies.
	Course Outcome	This course prepares a student of history for higher studies in history, archaeology, cultural studies and mass communication etc. They can also opt for competing in various administrative exams.
HINDI	Programme Outcome	The under graduate course in Hindi major incorporates Hindi literature from the 10th to the century and also includes Western and Eastern literature. Students would learn the role played by the poets of "Bhakti kal" in literature and society. They also gather knowledge on Hindi language. Students would get to know the socio economic and cultural conditions of medieval and modern Indian society through a study of selected novels, short stories and drama. Essays on literacy and topics of social, cultural and political consciousness enlighten the students about these aspects. Students would also learn applications of functional Hindi and translation through this course. A history of Hindi Literature will enable the students to understand its development. Students will understand the impact of women exploitation on society. A study on "Paryavaran" will increase the consciousness of the students on a healthy environ Students, will gain information on various religious and historical places of interest, archaeology variety and scope of agriculture. After completion of this course students will gain information on the Hindu culture and tradition. The course will provide in creative writing, proof reader.
	Programme Specific	Students will be able to understand the relation between society and literature and analyze the role played by Hindi literature in the past

	<p>Outcome</p>	<p>and present. Students will develop a philosophy of life inspired by the vision of eminent writers. Students will gain socio-cultural, gender and environmental consciousness. Competence in the language will empower their communication skills. After completion of this course students will gain information on the Hindu culture and tradition. The course will provide skills in creative writing. As a result of their proficiency in Hindi language, the students can find employment opportunities in Hindi language TV channels as well as contribute to the development of Hindi language, literature and culture as whole. They can engage themselves as teachers.</p>
	<p>Course Outcome</p>	<p>Students will be introduced to Hindi poetry of "Bhakti kal". Deals with the literature of 'Adikal ,Bhakti kal and Riti Kal' period, the contribution of various social reformers to the Hindi literature, the position of Hindi language and literature during the rule of Mughal periods. Deals with the literature of 'Bharatendu' period, the contribution of English missionaries to the Hindi literature, the position of Hindi language and literature during the rule of the English. Deals with a study of 'Indo – European' language and structure, 'Ancient Indian Arya Language', its structure and its difference with Modern Indian Arya language. It also gives an introduction of the history of origin of the Hindi language and a brief introduction to the languages of the surrounding states and their contribution to the Hindi language. Hindi works of fiction will be introduced through selected novels and short stories. Non frictional literature in Hindi through selected essays on literacy, socio-cultural and political topics will be introduced to the students. Students will be introduced to Hindi "Natya Sahitya "through a study of selected dramas. Students will attain knowledge of Assamese language and literature . Origin and development of Assamese Language. Deals with the language and content of Assamese Literature especially 'Bhakti-Kal and Aadhunik Kal' (upto Romantic Period). Students will gain knowledge of functional Hindi and its applications and translation. Students will be required to study the history of the development of literature. Students will be introduced to the origin of Hindi language and literature. The students will be acquainted with the forms of exploitations faced by women in a feudalistic system and its long drawn effects in society. Students will be introduced to the concept of "Payavaran" and its role in making human life healthy. Students will study the characteristics of Pre Sankari Literature and difference with modern literature and also the language of that time. It orients students to undertake a small academic project on Literature survey on life and literary works of a Hindi Literary genius (Hindi Sahityik Vibhuti).</p>
<p>POLITICAL SCIENCE</p>	<p>Programme Outcome</p>	<p>The Undergraduate course in Political Science has a significant thrust on Indian Constitution, Indian Politics and Government, Public Administration and International Relations. Comparative Govt. and Politics, Political Theory, Contemporary Political Issues. It also enables the students to learn about the constitutions of China, Switzerland, United Kingdoms and America. The course includes Sociology, Women and Politics, Western and Indian Political Thinkers and Human Rights.</p>
	<p>Programme Specific Outcome</p>	<p>The Undergraduate course in Political Science makes the students to know the working of the constitutional system in India. By studying the constitution the students gets acquainted with the rules regulations and other paraphernalia's with which the system runs. The public administration paper deals with the administration of the country. The students learn in detail about the mechanism</p>

The students are taught the intricacies of government functioning at the grass roots level. Local government provides the platform and also training ground for future politicians. It is the stepping stone for future progression into the national arena. Through this course the students are acquainted with the rights at the national as well as international level. They are also shown how to claim redressal in case the executive or for that matter or other organization tries to trespass with our rights.</p>
